Rules for vendors:

- > No loaded firearms
 - > No live artillery shells (disarmed or solid shot only)
 - > Vendors are responsible for any required firearm licenses needed
 - > Tables must be manned until closing time on Sunday unless prior arrangements are made. Those leaving early risk losing future vendor privileges.
 - > Vendors should have their tables uncovered and ready for business at the appropriate start time, and remain so until the show closes for the day.
 - > Any reproduction or fantasy pieces must be sold as such.
 - > Modern souvenirs, ie bumper stickers, license plates, t-shirts, etc. sold only with prior approval.
- Likewise, at our discretion, inappropriate or offensive items will be removed.
- > In order to present a professional look to the public, vendors must provide and use table covers.

We will provide qualified after-hours security Friday and Saturday night, but you are responsible for policing your own tables during show hours. It is suggested that merchandise be covered after hours. Finally, for everyone's safety and comfort, *American Digger*® is under no obligation to sell or offer vendor space to any applicant, and we also reserve the right to refuse admission to any individual.

Awards will be given for Best of Show, Best Display, Best Dug Artifact, Best Non Dug Artifact, and Most Educational.

We hope you are as excited as we are in what the future of the South Carolina Lowcountry Show will hold.
